5 Key Actions to run a successful (and manageable) Award program

1. **Youth Award Leaders** - Enlist students to help you run the program as their Service activity. Foster peer supported learning whilst lightening your workload!
2. **Team Approach** – Spread the word about The Award in your school/ organisation. Other teachers can support you just by knowing what the program is and encouraging the participants in their activities. Tap into the myriad of experience and knowledge amongst your colleagues to enrich the program.
3. **Community Links** - Form links with community organisations in the local area, get young people engaged and raise the profile of the school.
4. Call on your **Award Office** – Call or send an email, staff can also come to speak to coordinators, students, parents and other teachers. Ask about resources to enhance and strengthen your program.
5. **Celebrate** the students' achievements, both minor and major. Hold a celebration to thank your team and community partners; this will encourage them to support you next year!
